

## DOKIE 2 - WIND FARM EXPANSION

- ✓ **Location:** northwest of Fort St. John
  - Undeveloped ridgelines within Dokie Wind Farm area
- ✓ **Capacity & Production**
  - 156 MW generating 357 GWh annually
- ✓ **Project ownership**
  - 51 % - Alterra Power Corp
  - 49 % - GE Energy Financial Services
- ✓ **Permitting**
  - Existing permitting allows total with Dokie 1 of 300 MW
- ✓ **Timeline:**
  - Begin Construction - Q1 2013 E
  - On line - Q3 2014 E
- ✓ **Power Purchase Agreement**
  - Opportunity to discuss with BC Hydro and other off-takers

Located approximately northwest of Fort St John and about an hours drive northwest of Chetwynd, BC, the Dokie Wind Project is the largest commercial wind farm operation in British Columbia. The first phase consisted of 48 Vestas V90 wind turbines, a switchyard and seven kilometers of 230 kV transmission lines. The project is now fully operational and provides an average 330,000 MWh per year of clean energy to BC Hydro under a 25 year Electricity Purchase Agreement.

Wind assessments, turbine layout, infrastructure and financial studies are currently in progress for the Dokie 2 Wind Farm Expansion.
